
## registration under way for recreation programs

We debuted our first podcast in March, providing another way that you can keep up with Town news and events.

The audio newscast is available online and through various podcast catching applications such as Stitcher.

It airs on the 19th of each month. Episodes typically last 10 to 15 minutes.

Narrating the podcast is Don Briscar, Holly Springs Cultural Arts Center director. Podcasts have been gaining popularity with the advent of the smartphone. Applications like iTunes and Stitcher can catch the latest episodes of favorite audio programs and

hold them until listeners are ready to listen just by using the RSS feed (stands for Real Simple Syndication.)

You can find the podcast by hovering over the Quick Clicks menu on our Web site, www.hollyspringsnc.us. Find "hot topics" and click on "podcast."

Plans are to offer the Town podcast on iTunes soon.

#### keeping connected

With the arrival of spring, it's a good time to make sure you won't be caught off guard in case of severe weather.

One way is to sign up for automated phone, text or e-mail messages alerting you to emergencies.

We're using a free reverse 911 system made available by Wake County. With this system, we can call residents within a geographic area about severe weather and other imminent threats to public health and safety.

To use this free service, you must sign up for it. There are several ways to register.

The preferred way to sign up is to visit <a href="https://www.ReadyWake.com">www.ReadyWake.com</a> and register there.

Those who do not have an Internet connection can visit the Holly Springs Library to use a public computer.

You can also visit Town Hall and have us sign you up if you prefer.
