**A RESOLUTION OF THE HOLLY SPRINGS TOWN COUNCIL  
AUTHORIZING AWARD OF BADGE AND SALE OF SERVICE SIDE ARM  
TO A RETIRING LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER**

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council of the Town of Holly Springs, North Carolina, has determined that the Town owns certain personal property which has become surplus for the current needs of the Town, to wit: the side service arm of Sergeant Rick Leach, who is a retiring law enforcement officer with the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, North Carolina General Statute §20-187.2 permits the Town, upon request, to donate the badge worn by a law enforcement officer to said officer upon retirement; and


**WHEREAS**, North Carolina General Statute §20-187.2 permits the Town, upon request, to sell the service side arm to the retiring law enforcement officer upon securing such a permit required by law or without such permit if the weapon has been rendered incapable of being fired;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Holly Springs Town Council that a Glock 17, 9mm weapon with serial number ZTZ760 is declared surplus to the needs of the Town of Holly Springs; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that, to honor the service of Sergeant Rick Leach as a law enforcement officer, the Town Council of Holly Springs authorizes the Police Chief to donate the badge worn by said officer, and further authorizes the sale of the following service side arm, which is declared surplus, to said officer for the price of \$1.00, with the payment of said purchase price to be waived in consideration of this officer's loyal service to the citizens of Holly Springs; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that property described in this resolution is surplus as of Dec. 1, 2018.
