Executive Summary Summer 2009

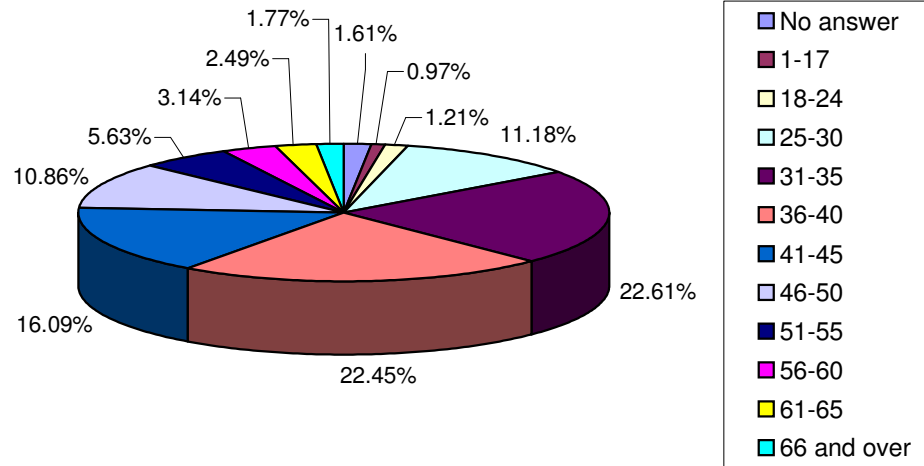

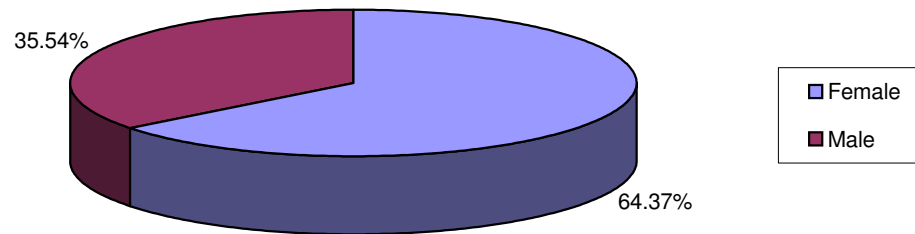

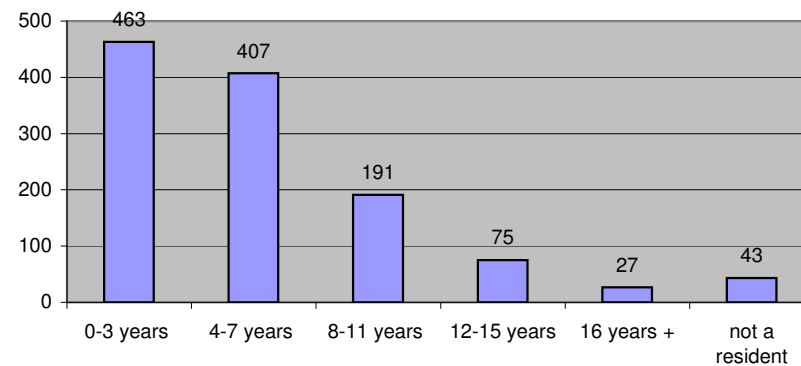

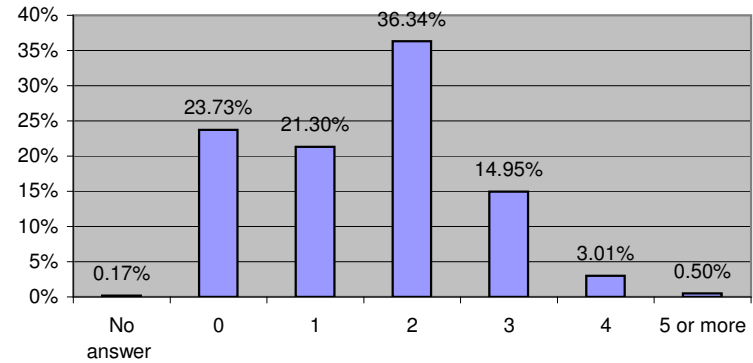
3) How long have you been a resident of Holly Springs?

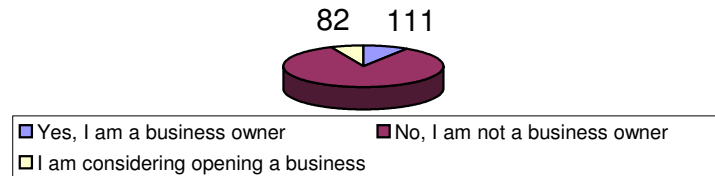

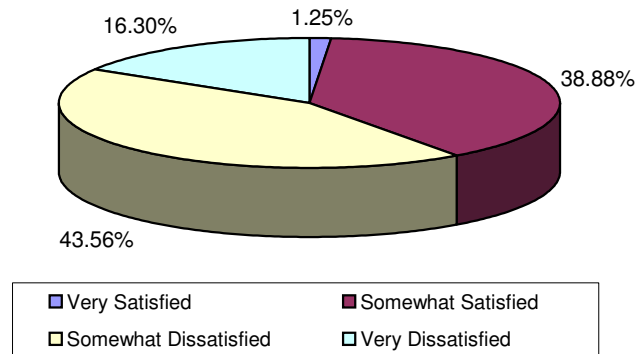
5) Are you a business owner in Holly Springs or are you considering starting a business?

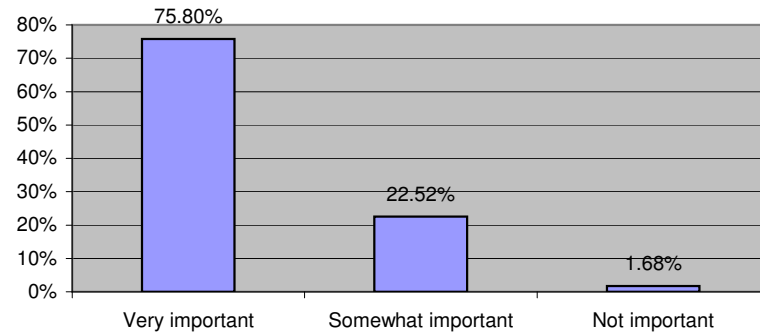
6) How satisfied are you with the variety of shops and services available in Holly Springs?

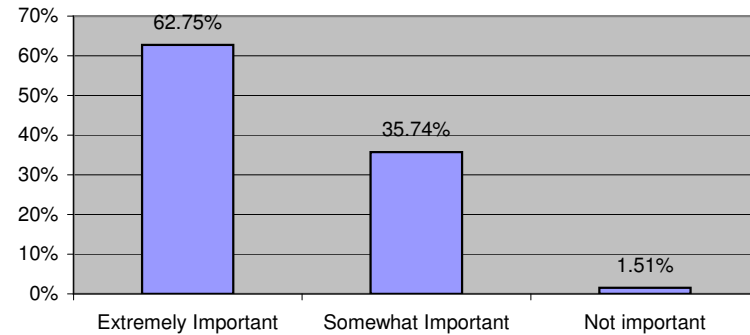
7) How important do you feel it is to make your purchases in Holly Springs and support local businesses?

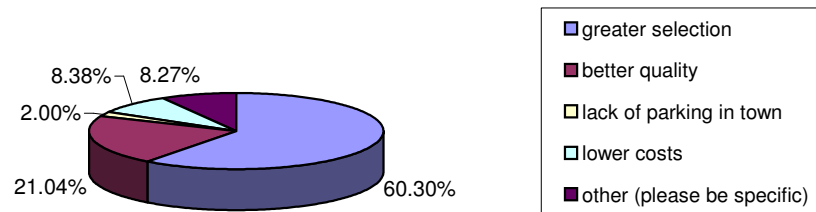
8) How important is drive-time when deciding where to shop?

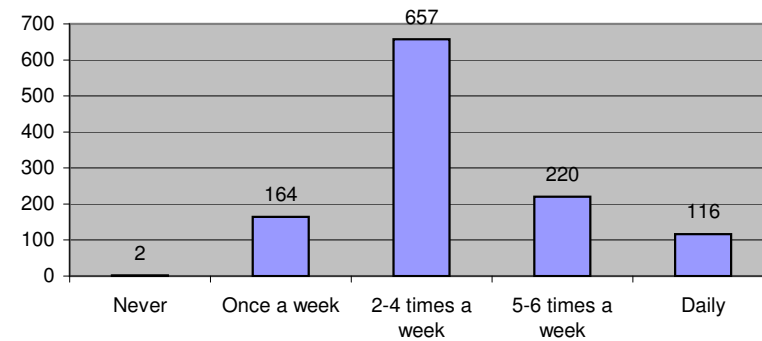

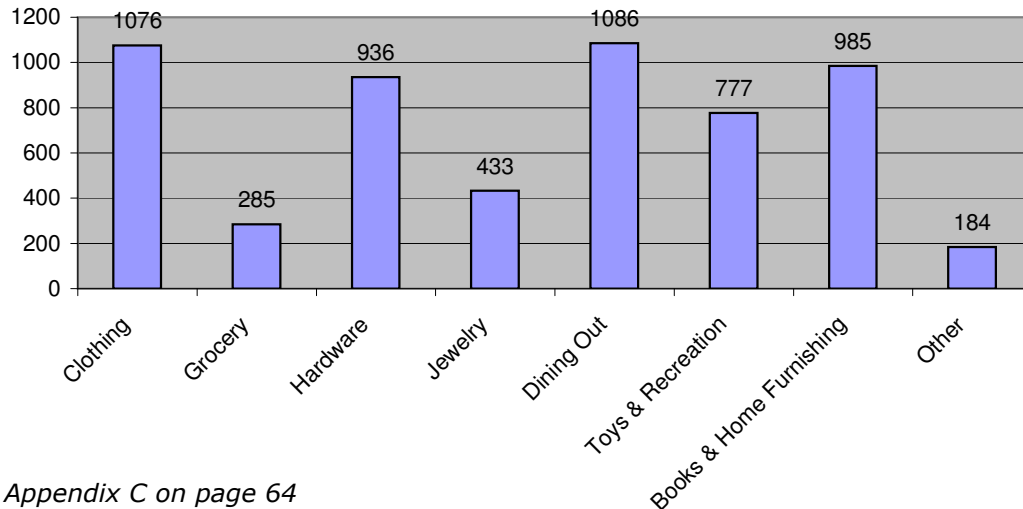


11) What retailers would you like to have in Holly Springs?

12) What types of purchases do you leave Holly Springs to make?

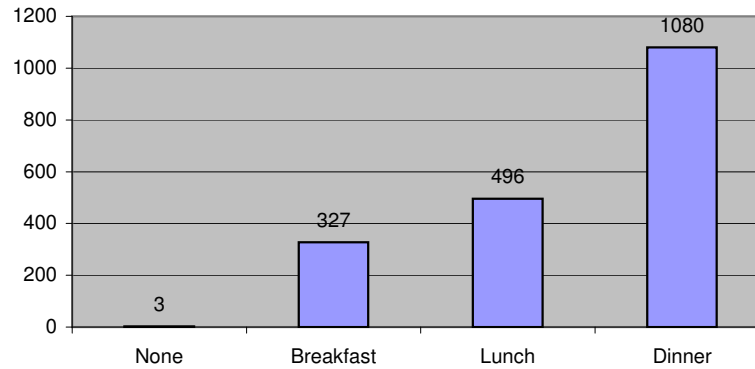

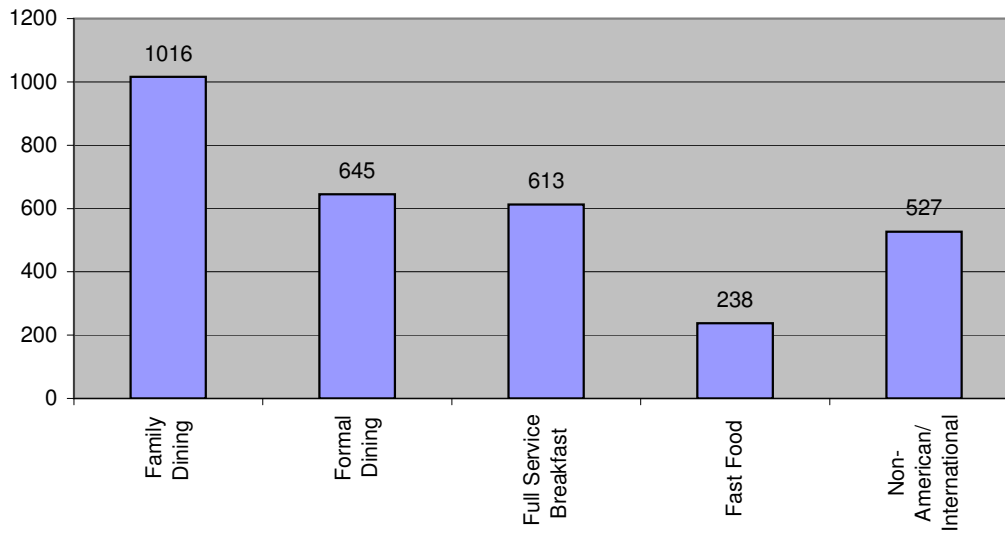

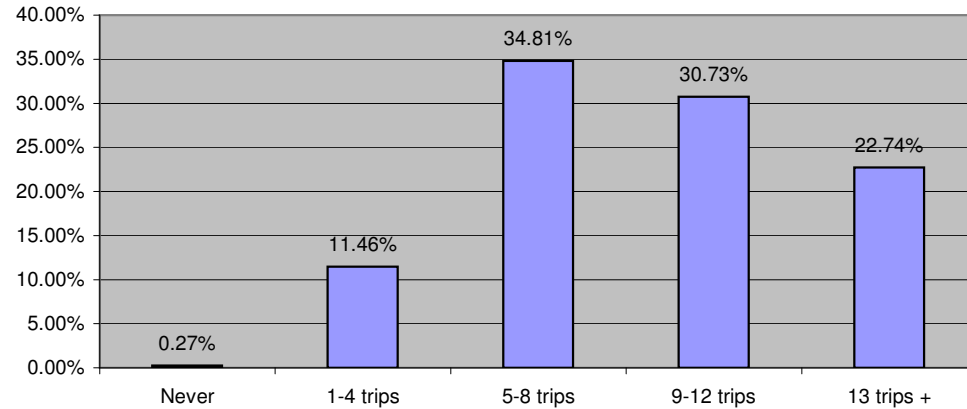
14) Do you perceive a need for more restaurants in Holly Springs? If so, what type?

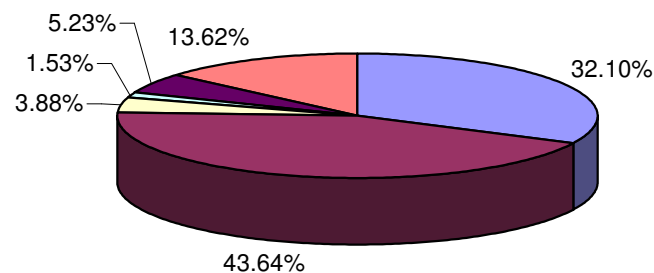
