



**Recreation Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes

CALL TO ORDER: Peter called the meeting to order

APPROVAL OF 3/14/13 MINUTES: Minutes approved.

FOOTBALL & CHEER CHANGES UPDATE: Len stated that the Town had looked into new leagues as a result of the Town Council direction to continue competitive play for the next year. The Central league had in the past been a league of both municipalities and private organizations. Municipalities left the league and the league and have formed a new league. Len provided the board with a copy of an email he received today from Landon Carroll, Athletics program manager. The email stated that the Town has been accepted to play in the new league. This league consists of all municipal parks and recreation programs. Cheer will be allowed with the football program within this league. Guidelines will be provided by the league for the cheer program as outlined by the American Recreation Cheerleading Association. The league will be divided into an East and West division in order to cut down on travel distances. Within this league, there are no fees associated with the games and each parks and recreation department serves on the board of directors.

Kevin made a motion to approve and support the department's participation in the Central Piedmont football league. Wanda second. All in favor. Motion passes unanimously. Kevin made a motion to send the Board's thanks to Landon and Kristen for their hard work on this issue. Peter second. All in favor. Motion passes unanimously.

SUGG MASTER PLAN UPDATE: Kevin provided an update on the Sugg Farm Master Plan committee's first meeting. The committee members met in March to discuss their ideas and thoughts about the master plan for the property. Len shared that he thought the meeting went very well. A lot was accomplished and the committee and consultants worked well together. The second meeting will be held on Wednesday, April 17 at the Hunt Recreation Center.
