MINUTES

The Holly Springs Town Council met in a duly called special session on Tuesday, May 5, 2015 in the parking lot of Holly Springs Town Hall, 128 S. Main Street. Mayor Sears presided, calling the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. The stated purpose for the special meeting was for the Council to tour the construction site of the North Main Athletic Complex.

Mr. Bradley and Mr. Huffman led the group of Council members and staff on a tour of the facility, which is nearing completion. The North Main Athletic Complex consists of soccer fields, tennis courts, a multi-sport athletics stadium, a playground and parking. The current phases of the project should be completed by this summer. Future phases will provide permanent office space and a community meeting and event space. NMAC will be completed enough for the opening home game of the Coastal Plain League's Holly Springs Salamanders May 28.

No action was taken during this special meeting and it was adjourned at the close of the tour at 6:30 p.m.
