



Spring 2021 Soccer Game Season FAQ

- Parents are required to self-assess their children before attending each training session. If symptoms are present or attendees have been exposed to someone with COVID-19, do not attend the activity and notify your team's coach and a HSPR full-time staff member.
- Spectators should be limited to three (3) per family. Participants and spectators should remain in their vehicles until 10 minutes prior to their activity start time, or until the current group on the field has time to depart.
- Current executive orders will be followed. As of now, all participants and coaches are required to wear a face covering at all times. Spectators must wear a face covering when they are unable to social distance or are within six (6) feet of anyone residing outside their household.
- Each team will practice twice per week prior to the start of games. Each team will have a 6-game regular season. Once games begin, practices may be scheduled if field space allows. A single-elimination tournament will follow the regular season for the 9 year's old and up leagues.
- Players are expected to provide their own soccer ball for the practices. Size 3 ball for 8 years old and younger. Size 4 ball for 9-12-year olds. Size 5 ball for 14-17-year olds.
- Our department will provide jerseys and socks. Players will be required to provide shorts (no specific color), shin guards and cleats.
- Coaches will receive their rosters the week prior to the start of the start of practices. All parents should be contacted by their child's head coach no later than Thursday, April 15th.
- Any players that participated in the **SPRING 2020 soccer program**, and are still in the same age group, will be eligible to return to their teams. Training season rosters will **NOT** carryover to this season.
- For the 9-10 and older leagues, HSPR staff members will work with coaches to draft the most balanced teams possible.
- For the 7-8 and younger leagues, teams will be assigned by HSPR staff. Head coaches may request 3 assistant coaches to be assigned to their teams.
- No other special requests for team placement will be taken.
